

GroceryRoute

Shop in the order you walk the store.

GroceryRoute is a shopping list that learns. Every time you shop, it watches the order you check things off and quietly builds a map of your path through each store. The next time you make a list, it's already sorted the way you walk — produce first, frozen last, no more zig-zagging back across the store for the one thing you missed.

1. Add Your Stores

GroceryRoute organizes everything around the stores you actually shop at. Each store keeps its own list, its own history, and its own learned route.

1. Tap the **+** button on the My Stores screen.
2. Name the store (e.g. Trader Joe's, Costco) and pick an icon.
3. Tap **Add**. Repeat for every store you shop at.

To edit a store later, swipe right on it. To remove one, swipe left.

2. Build Your List

Open a store and use the search bar at the top. GroceryRoute remembers every item you've ever added, so building a list gets faster every week.

- **Type an item** — matching items you've used before appear as you type; tap one to add it, or tap **Add "..."** to add something brand new.
- **Quick-add chips** — your most-used items appear as green chips under the search bar. One tap adds them.
- **Already on the list?** — if you type something that's already there, GroceryRoute tells you instead of adding a duplicate.
- **Use Siri (Pro)** — say “Hey Siri, add an item in GroceryRoute” and add things hands-free, even while cooking.

Tip: New items you've never bought before appear at the top of the list, so you'll spot them right away on your next trip.

3. Master Lists (Reusable Bundles) — Pro

A master list is a named bundle of items you buy together — think “Taco Night”, “Thanksgiving”, or “Weekly Staples”. Build it once, drop it into any store's list with one tap.

1. From My Stores, tap the list icon in the top-left corner to create and edit master lists.

2. While building a store list, open the **three-dot menu** and choose **Add Master List**.
3. The bundle appears as its own collapsible group on your list, so big lists stay tidy.

4. Shop

At the store, just tap the circle next to each item as it goes in your cart. Checked items move to the **In Cart** section (tap again to move one back).

This is where the magic happens: the order you check items off is how GroceryRoute learns your route. After a trip or two, your list sorts itself to match the way you actually walk the store — look for the **Route order** badge on the list header.

Glance at your Lock Screen: once you check off your first item, a Live Activity appears on the Lock Screen and Dynamic Island showing your progress and the next few items — no need to keep unlocking your phone in the aisle.

5. Complete Your Trip

When everything's checked off, a green **Complete Trip** button appears at the bottom. Tap it and you're done — the app returns to My Stores, and each store card shows the date of your last trip in green.

Completed trips are saved in **Trip History** (in the three-dot menu) — your last 3 trips on the free tier, every trip ever with Pro. Pro also lets you correct a trip's item order by dragging — GroceryRoute treats your corrections as extra-strong route hints.

6. Shortcuts for Next Time

- **Repeat Last Trip** — in the three-dot menu; refills your list with everything from your previous trip.
- **Learned Route** — also in the three-dot menu; shows the aisle order GroceryRoute has learned for that store.
- **Start New List** — archives the current list to history and gives you a fresh start.
- **Rename an item** — swipe right on it. Fixing a typo (“Mlik” to “Milk”) updates it everywhere: suggestions, learned routes, and past trips.
- **Delete an item** — swipe left on it.

Free vs Pro

GroceryRoute is free to use forever with one store. A single one-time purchase — GroceryRoute Pro, \$4.99, no subscription — unlocks everything else.

Unlock Pro from any locked feature in the app, and use **Restore Purchases** to bring it to a new phone.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why isn't my list in aisle order yet?

GroceryRoute needs to watch you shop first. Check items off in the order you pick them up, and the route gets sharper with every trip.

I shop the same store differently sometimes. Will that break it?

No — recent trips count more than old ones, so the route adapts if your path changes.

Where did my list go after I completed the trip?

It's saved in Trip History (three-dot menu inside the store). Nothing is ever lost.

Does GroceryRoute need an account or internet?

No. Everything lives on your device — no sign-up, no tracking, works in a concrete-walled supermarket with zero bars.

Is Pro a subscription?

No — Pro is a single one-time purchase. Buy it once and it's yours forever.
